

12-pin junction box splicing



Overview

The most common method for splicing solid conductors in a junction box involves creating a pigtail connection secured by a twist-on wire connector. Proper wire splicing within this enclosure is necessary to ensure the long-term reliability of the electrical system and prevent the risk of fire from loose. Summary: Electrical junction box splices can be made safely when you understand the method. This example will show you step by step how to make a outlet box wire splice. Never pull spliced or skinned wire through conduit and never splice in at or below ground level. Always leave a 1-2 foot service loop at each splice, at each remote, and at each power supply to allow for future maintenance or repair. Displayed prices are inclusive of all applicable tariff and duty. A 6"x6"x4" jbox would meet code if all wiring.
