An optical adapter component is a passive device that aligns and connects two optical fibers or modules, ensuring efficient light transmission with minimal loss.

Overview

An optical adapter—also called a coupler or bulkhead coupler—is a passive mechanical interface that mates two terminated optical fibers or connects optical modules, allowing light to pass reliably from one fiber to another with minimal insertion loss and low reflectance (). Adapters are essential in fiber-optic communications, data centers, enterprise networks, and test & measurement setups ().

Types of Optical Adapters

- **Inline Adapters:** Stand-alone devices that join two fiber cables directly. They are commonly used for temporary connections or flexible patching ().
- **Bulkhead Adapters:** Panel-mounted adapters installed in fiber patch panels, outlets, or equipment bulkheads. They provide a fixed interface for connecting fibers or modules ().
- **Mode Field Adapters (MFA):** Specialized adapters that connect fibers with different core diameters or numerical apertures, often used in fiber laser applications ().
- **Multi-Fiber Adapters:** Designed for MPO/MTP connectors, enabling high-density connections with multiple fibers in a single interface ().
