

Aggregation Switch Installation Process



Article Overview

Installing an aggregation switch involves physical setup, stacking, uplink/downlink configuration, and initial network management to ensure efficient traffic aggregation and high availability.

Understanding the Aggregation Switch

An aggregation switch consolidates traffic from multiple access switches, wireless access points, or edge devices and forwards it to core switches or routers, operating at Layer 2 or Layer 3 depending on network design . It enhances bandwidth, redundancy, and failover capability through link aggregation protocols like LACP or static link aggregation . Aggregation switches are commonly deployed in enterprise backbones, data centers, and large campus networks .

Physical Installation

- **Rack Mounting:** Secure the switch in a standard 19-inch rack using the provided brackets. Ensure proper ventilation and clearance around the device .
- **Power Connection:** Connect the switch to a reliable power source. For PoE-capable models, verify the PoE budget to ensure sufficient power for connected devices .
- **Cabling:** Connect uplink ports to core switches and downlink ports to access switches or APs. Use high-quality Ethernet or fiber cables as required .
- **Stacking (Optional):** If supported, stack multiple aggregation switches to increase interface density and provide device-level redundancy. Configure stacking ports according to the manufacturer's instructions .
