

Assembly of secondary power distribution boxes on construction sites



Article Overview

Secondary power distribution boxes on construction sites are installed as robust, portable, and code-compliant sub-distribution units that safely deliver electricity from the main supply to work zones and equipment.

Planning and Design

Before installation, determine the load requirements for each work zone, including continuous loads (lighting, temporary offices) and high inrush current equipment (hydraulic tools, concrete splitters) to calculate the required capacity and conductor sizing . Define the network type (typically three-phase 400 V for machinery and 230 V for small consumers) and plan the distribution structure, including main and secondary sub-distributions, short feeders, and reserves for peak loads .

Box Selection and Environmental Protection

Choose IP-rated outdoor enclosures (IP65 or higher) to protect against dust, water jets, and mud . The box should be elevated from the ground to prevent moisture ingress and allow safe cable entry. Internal wiring should be organized, with clearly labeled circuits and industrial CEE sockets (IEC 60309) for reliable connections . Emergency stop buttons should be included for rapid shutdown in case of faults.

Installation Steps

- **Positioning:** Place the secondary distribution box in a stable, accessible location near the work zone, avoiding areas prone to flooding or heavy foot traffic .
