Overview

They are used for secondary load distribution and offer multiple poles and form C (changeover) contact configurations. Environment — Temperature range, fluids, pressure cycles, icing, salt fog, vibration. EMI/EMC — Shielding level; filtered inserts or 360° braid termination. Mating style — Threaded for harsh vibration; bayonet for quick access; push-pull for compact instruments. Contact mix — Sizes.
