A fiber optic cable cannot reliably transmit data if it breaks at a cold splice; it must be repaired through proper splicing to restore signal continuity.

Understanding Cold Splice Breaks

A cold splice is a mechanical connection where two fiber ends are aligned and held together without fusion. If the cable breaks at this point, the glass core is physically severed, interrupting the light path that carries data, which results in complete signal loss or high attenuation. Unlike electrical cables, even a small misalignment or break in a fiber optic strand prevents data transmission.

Repair Options

To restore functionality, the broken splice must be repaired. There are two main methods:

- **Fusion Splicing:** The broken fiber ends are precisely aligned and fused using heat, creating a continuous glass path with minimal signal loss (typically
