Butterfly-shaped optical cables are flat, wing-like fiber optic cables designed for easy installation, minimal bending stress, and reliable high-speed data transmission.

Design and Structure

Butterfly-shaped optical cables get their name from their cross-sectional shape, which resembles a butterfly. The cable features a flat profile with the optical fiber at the center and two parallel strength members on either side, often made of Fiber Reinforced Plastic (FRP) or steel for outdoor self-supporting variants. This design allows the cable to bend easily in the flat plane, reducing stress on the fiber core, while bending edge-on requires more force, providing protection against accidental kinks. Indoor versions typically use FRP strength members and a Low Smoke Zero Halogen (LSZH) sheath, making them lightweight, flexible, and suitable for routing through walls, ceilings, or small spaces. Outdoor self-supporting variants add a steel messenger wire, enabling aerial deployment without additional support, with spans up to 50 meters.

Fiber Type and Performance

Butterfly cables almost universally use bend-insensitive single-mode fibers, such as ITU-T G.657 types, which tolerate tight bend radii and maintain low signal loss. This makes them ideal for fiber-to-the-home (FTTH), data centers, and other high-bandwidth applications.
