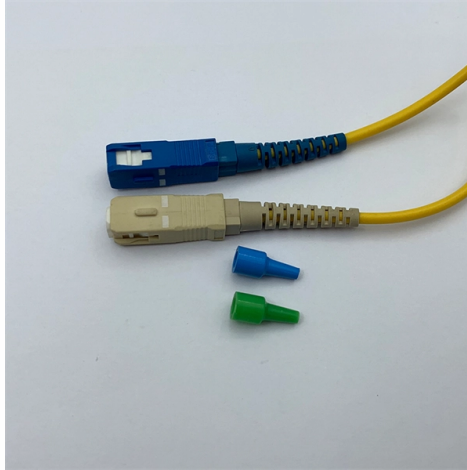

As of 2019, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) released new requirements for tower marking. Any landowners are now required to mark any towers between 50' to 200' on their property. Each color serves as a visual cue for specific operational conditions. Workers rely on these signals to understand equipment status quickly.
