

Connecting a 96-port fiber optic box to a switch

Use SFP/SFP+ transceivers with duplex LC fiber cables, ensuring proper port matching and reversed send/receive connections for reliable 96-port fiber connectivity.

Step 1: Identify Switch and Port Types

Determine the type of fiber optic ports on your switch. Common port types include SFP, SFP+, QSFP+, XFP, or CFP. For a 96-port fiber switch, such as the Cisco MDS 9396T, ports are typically 32-Gbps SFP+ capable of supporting high-speed Fibre Channel connections. Check the switch documentation or physical labeling to confirm port type and supported transceiver modules.

Step 2: Select Appropriate Transceiver Modules

Choose SFP or SFP+ transceivers compatible with both the switch and the fiber optic cabling. Consider:

- Fiber type: Single-mode (OS2) or multimode (OM3/OM4)
- Bandwidth: 1G, 10G, or higher depending on switch capability
- Connector type: Most modern SFP modules use LC duplex connectors
