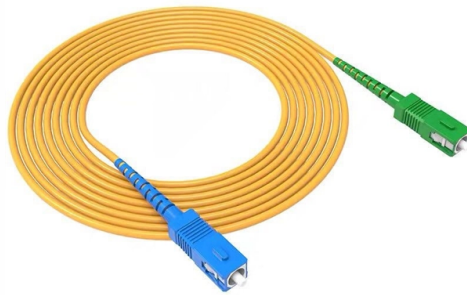


Connection between current in the distribution box and cables



Article Overview

The current in a distribution box flows from the main supply through protective devices to the connected cables, and the cable size and rating must match the expected current to ensure safe operation.

How Current Flows in a Distribution Box

A distribution box, also called a consumer unit or panel board, receives the main electrical supply and distributes it to multiple circuits through protective devices such as MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers), RCDs (Residual Current Devices), and fuses (). The main supply enters the box via a double-pole MCB or main switch, which controls the overall current entering the system. From there, the current is routed to busbars, which act as common connection points for outgoing circuits (). Each outgoing circuit is connected to a single-pole MCB or, for special loads, a double-pole MCB. The current drawn by each load flows through these MCBs and then into the connected cables, which carry the current to lights, appliances, or other devices ().

Cable Selection and Current Rating

The current rating of the cable must match or exceed the maximum current expected in the circuit. If the cable is undersized, it can overheat, leading to insulation damage or fire hazards. The MCB protects the cable by tripping when the current exceeds its rated value, preventing overloads (). For example, a 20A MCB should be paired with a cable rated for at least 20A continuous current.
