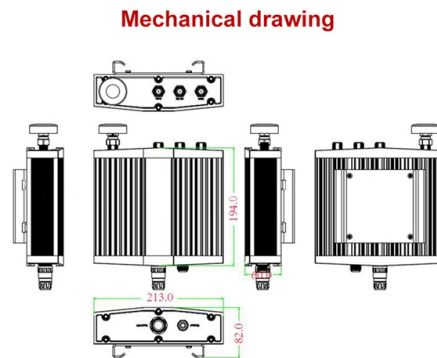


Distribution Box Load Configuration



Article Overview

Load settings in a distribution box are determined by calculating total electrical load, selecting appropriately rated breakers, and arranging circuits with proper protection and future expansion in mind.

Understanding the Distribution Box

A distribution box is a low-voltage enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, and surge protectors. It typically contains a main switch or isolator, phase busbars, neutral and earth bars, and space for outgoing circuit breakers (). The enclosure should have an appropriate IP/NEMA rating for protection against dust, water, and impact, and be made of durable materials like steel or plastic depending on the installation environment ().

Calculating Load and Selecting Breakers

- **Determine Total Load:** List all circuits in the building, including lighting, outlets, appliances, and specialized equipment. Group loads as resistive, inductive, or capacitive and apply diversity factors since not all devices operate simultaneously ().
- **Select Breaker Ratings:** Each outgoing circuit should have a breaker rated according to the conductor size, load type, and installation method. MCBs protect against overload and short circuits, while RCDs or RCBOs provide residual-current protection to reduce shock risk ().
- **Safety Margins:** Include a 10-25% margin above calculated load to accommodate future expansion or unexpected increases in demand ().
