

Distribution Box Plan Dimensions



Article Overview

Plan a distribution box by calculating total load, counting circuits, adding spare slots, and allowing space for future expansion while considering physical installation constraints.

Step 1: List All Circuits

Start by listing every circuit in your system, including lighting, outlets, and specialized equipment. Identify the voltage requirements for each circuit: 120V circuits typically use single-pole breakers, while 240V circuits require double-pole breakers. This helps determine how many slots each circuit will occupy in the distribution box .

Step 2: Calculate Total Load

Sum the amperage of all circuits to determine the total electrical load. This ensures the main breaker and the distribution box can safely handle the current. Consider both residential and commercial standards, following NEC, IEC, or local codes .

Step 3: Add Spare Slots

Include at least two spare slots for troubleshooting or small additions. This acts as an “emergency fund” for unexpected circuits or temporary installations .

Step 4: Plan for Future Expansion

Add 20-25% extra capacity to accommodate future growth, such as additional appliances, EV chargers, or lighting upgrades. For example, if your current setup requires 18 slots, plan for 23-24 slots to avoid overcrowding later .

Step 5: Consider Physical Dimensions
