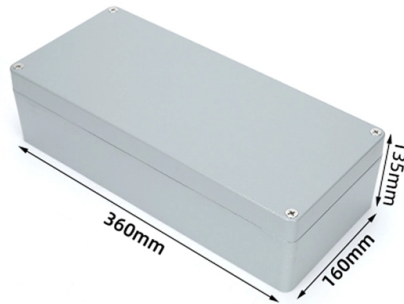


Distribution box Diverter box

A distribution box (D-box) or diverter box evenly distributes wastewater from a septic tank to multiple drain field lines, ensuring balanced flow and preventing overload.

Function and Purpose

A distribution box, often called a D-box, is a small container installed between a septic tank and the drain field. Its primary role is to receive effluent from the septic tank and distribute it evenly to the various drain field lines, preventing any single area from becoming overloaded, which could lead to system failure or environmental contamination. A diverter box or splitter box is a variation that allows more precise control of effluent flow. It can include manual plugs, caps, or control valves to direct wastewater to specific drain field segments, sometimes allowing sections to rest and extend the life of the drain field.

Types of Distribution Boxes

- Concrete D-boxes: Durable and long-lasting, commonly used in traditional septic systems.
- Plastic D-boxes: Made from high-density polyethylene (HDPE), lightweight, resistant to corrosion, and easier to install, though less durable than concrete.
- Fiberglass D-boxes: Strong, corrosion-resistant, and low-maintenance, but more expensive than concrete or plastic.
- Pumped Distribution Systems: Used when the drain field is at a higher elevation than the septic tank; a pump moves effluent to the D-box for even distribution.
