

Does 88 access panels require a core switch



Article Overview

The Texecom Premier Elite 88 does not inherently require a core switch; a standard access-layer switch is typically sufficient for connecting its panels and expanders.

System Overview

The Premier Elite 88 is a hybrid security system capable of supporting up to 88 zones, 8 wired expanders, 8 keypads, and 100 user codes . It is designed to integrate multiple wired and wireless devices, including motion detectors, contacts, shock sensors, and external sounders. The system's expanders and panels communicate primarily for security monitoring and control, rather than high-volume data transfer.

Networking Considerations

In network design, core switches serve as the high-speed backbone connecting distribution switches and handling massive traffic volumes with ultra-low latency . They are essential in large enterprise networks where multiple access switches aggregate heavy data traffic, requiring high-speed routing and fault tolerance. Access switches, on the other hand, operate at the network edge and connect end devices like IP phones, PCs, or security panels . They provide sufficient port density, Power over Ethernet (PoE) if needed, and basic Layer 2 switching, which is generally adequate for the Premier Elite 88's communication needs.

Practical Recommendation

For a typical installation with 88 zones and a few expanders, a reliable access-layer switch is sufficient. A core switch would only be necessary if:
