

# EU Distribution Box Configuration Table



## Article Overview

EU distribution boxes are configured according to IEC 61439 / EN 61439 standards, with layouts specifying incoming devices, outgoing circuits, protection elements, and country-specific variations.

### Overview of EU Distribution Box Configuration

European distribution boxes, also known as low-voltage switchgear assemblies, are designed to safely distribute electrical power in residential, commercial, and small industrial buildings. Configurations are guided by IEC 61439 / EN 61439, which ensures compliance with safety, temperature rise, and short-circuit withstand requirements (Hensel guide) . The configuration table typically includes:

- Incoming devices: Main circuit breakers or fuses that control the overall supply.
- Outgoing circuits: Individual circuit breakers for lighting, sockets, and specialized equipment.
- Protection elements: Residual current devices (RCDs), surge protection, and overcurrent protection.
- Busbar and wiring layout: Standardized for safe and efficient distribution.
- Documentation: Type plates, wiring diagrams, and parts lists for compliance and maintenance .
