

Estonian Single-Fiber Bidirectional OSFP



Article Overview

The Estonian Single-Fiber Bidirectional OSFP is a high-speed optical transceiver solution enabling 800G and beyond over a single fiber using OSFP modules with bidirectional transmission.

Overview of OSFP

OSFP stands for Octal Small Form-factor Pluggable, a modular transceiver standard designed for high-density, high-speed data center applications. The OSFP module measures 22mm in width, larger than QSFP-DD, which improves thermal performance and allows operation at speeds of 400G, 800G, and up to 1.6T. The octal designation refers to eight electrical lanes, each capable of 50G PAM4 for 400G, 100G PAM4 for 800G, and 200G per lane for 1.6T, providing high signal integrity and reduced crosstalk. OSFP modules integrate thermal management features, including heatsinks, to maintain performance in high-density deployments.

Single-Fiber Bidirectional Technology

Single-fiber bidirectional (BiDi) transceivers allow simultaneous transmission and reception over a single optical fiber, effectively doubling fiber utilization and reducing cabling complexity. This technology is particularly useful in data center interconnects (DCIs) and high-density network environments where fiber availability is limited. BiDi OSFP modules can support long-distance links, as demonstrated in recent deployments achieving 2x30.4 Tb/s over 60.85 km of Hollow Core Fiber with 800G ZR OSFP modules. These modules also support extended distances up to 121.7 km using high-power amplification.
