Cable trays are externally connected using splice plates, bolted connections, clamps, quick-connect systems, and welding to ensure stability, safety, and ease of maintenance.

Common External Connection Methods

1. Splice Plates and Bolted Connections Splice plates are flat metal plates with pre-drilled holes used to join two tray sections in a straight line. They are bolted to the ends of the trays, providing a strong and secure connection suitable for most tray types. Bolted connections allow for disassembly if modifications are needed and are widely used for long, straight runs of cable trays. Installation requires tools such as spanners or torque wrenches and takes more time compared to other methods, but it ensures system stability and durability . 2. Quick Connect Systems These are specialized systems designed to snap, slide, or twist together, often requiring few or no tools. Quick connect systems are ideal for large projects where installation speed is critical. They are usually brand-specific and may have a higher upfront cost, but they save labor time and simplify assembly . 3. Angle and Junction Plates L, T, or cross-shaped plates are used to connect trays at angles or junctions, allowing cables to route around corners or splits. These plates are essential for complex layouts and maintaining proper cable organization . 4. Clamps Clamps are used to secure tray sections together, especially in modular or adjustable systems. They provide flexibility for minor adjustments and are often used in combination with other connection methods to enhance stability . 5. Welding Welding is a permanent method for joining metal trays, providing maximum strength and rigidity. It is less common due to the need for skilled labor and the inability to easily modify the system after installation .
