Fiber Optic Splitters

A fiber optic splitter is a passive optical device that divides a single incoming optical signal into two or more outgoing signals without requiring power, making it highly reliable and cost-effective for large networks. Splitters are commonly used in FTTH (Fiber to the Home) networks to allow a single fiber from a provider to serve multiple homes or devices. They operate bidirectionally, meaning they can also combine signals from multiple inputs. Key Features:

- Split Ratios: Common ratios include 1:2, 1:4, 1:8, 1:16, and 1:32, determining how the input signal is distributed among outputs.
- Technologies:
 - FBT (Fused Biconical Taper): Fibers are fused and tapered together to split light, suitable for small port counts and multimode fibers.
 - PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit): Uses waveguide circuits on a silica substrate, ideal for high port counts and single-mode fibers.
- Applications: Used in passive optical networks, data centers, and telecommunications to efficiently share fiber infrastructure.
