Overview of Single-Mode vs. Multimode Connectors

Single-mode connectors are designed for fibers with a $9\mu\text{m}$ core, allowing light to travel in a straight path, minimizing dispersion, and supporting long-distance, high-bandwidth applications such as backbone networks and long-haul communication links. Multimode connectors accommodate fibers with $50\mu\text{m}$ to $62.5\mu\text{m}$ cores, supporting multiple light paths, which makes them ideal for short-distance, high-data-rate applications like data centers and LANs.

Common Connector Types

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LC (Lucent Connector): A small-form-factor connector widely used in SFP modules and high-density environments. Available in single-mode and multimode, with PC (Physical Contact) or APC (Angled Physical Contact) polishing. APC variants reduce back reflection, making them preferable for single-mode applications.

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SC (Subscriber Connector): A push-pull connector with a 2.5mm ferrule, used in both single-mode and multimode networks. SC/APC connectors feature an angled ferrule to minimize reflections, commonly used in telecommunications and data centers.
