- Determine the Mounting Location: Choose a wall, pole, or rack location that is accessible for maintenance and protected from environmental hazards. For indoor boxes, ensure proximity to ONTs or routers .
- Mount the Box: Use brackets or mounting screws to secure the box. For concrete or brick walls, drill pilot holes and insert anchors before fastening screws. Avoid over-tightening, especially for plastic enclosures .
