

# How far is the third-level distribution box from the ground



## Overview

What should the distance be between the floor and the distribution board or main switch?

Approved Document M of the Building Regulations states that consumer units/fuseboxes should be mounted so that the switches are 1350-1450mm above floor level. The National Electrical Code (NEC) article 110. Its primary purpose is to ensure that electricians and maintenance personnel have sufficient, unobstructed space to work on energized equipment safely and effectively. 8 meters above the ground, which is convenient for operation and inspection. The main issue is what the box is listed for, height from ground. The IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) and BS 7671 (British Standard for Electrical Installations) both provide essential requirements for electrical installations, including those for fuse boards like garage unit, consumer unit and distribution board. "Two-level protection" mainly refers to the use of leakage protection.

Distribution box and switch box should not exceed 30 meters. The horizontal distance between switchbox and fixed electrical equipment should not exceed 3m.
