Split Ratios: Defining How Optical Signals Are Divided A split ratio describes how many output ports a splitter has, and how evenly the input optical power is distributed across those ports. For example, a 1:32 splitter takes 1 input signal and splits it into 32 equal (or nearly equal) output. Any time a TV signal is split, it will encounter insertion loss that will weaken the signals distributed beyond the splitter. Multiple output ports: These are where the split signals are.
