

How to connect a pigtail to a mirror port



Article Overview

To connect a fiber optic pigtail to a mirror port, fusion-splice the bare end of the pigtail to the trunk cable in a splice tray, then plug the connector end into the mirror port; prices typically range from \$2 to \$10 per pigtail depending on type and jacket.

Step-by-Step Connection

- **Select the Correct Pigtail:** Choose a pigtail that matches your fiber type and connector standard. For single-mode networks (FTTH, GPON), SC/APC or LC/UPC pigtails are common. For multimode data center applications, OM3/OM4 LC pigtails are standard. Buffer diameters (0.9 mm, 2.0 mm, 3.0 mm) should match your splice tray or closure requirements .
- **Prepare the Fiber:** Strip the protective jacket from the bare end of the pigtail and clean the fiber. Cleave the fiber precisely to ensure a low-loss splice .
- **Fusion Splicing:** Place the bare end of the pigtail and the trunk or distribution fiber into a fusion splicer. Align and fuse the fibers to create a permanent, low-loss connection inside a splice tray or fiber distribution box .
- **Connect to Mirror Port:** Once spliced, the factory-terminated connector end of the pigtail can be plugged directly into the mirror port on your switch, network tap, or monitoring device .
- **Test the Connection:** Use an optical power meter or OTDR to verify signal integrity and ensure minimal insertion loss .
