

How to connect pigtails and jumper cables

Electrical Pigtails

In residential or commercial wiring, a pigtail is a short wire used to connect the main circuit wires to a device, such as an outlet or switch. This method ensures that the device is not directly dependent on the main circuit for continuity, preventing a single device failure from interrupting downstream power. Steps to connect electrical pigtails:

- Turn off power at the main breaker and verify with a voltage tester.
- Strip the insulation from the ends of the main wires and the pigtail wire.
- Twist the main wires together with the pigtail using a wire nut.
- Connect the pigtail to the device terminal.
- Secure the device in the junction box and restore power. This method is required by the National Electrical Code for grounding conductors and ensures a safer, more reliable connection.
