

How to handle the absence of a small busbar on the top of the cabinet

Assess the Panel Layout

- **Use Busbar Adapters or Terminal Blocks:** If a full busbar is not available, you can use busbar adapters, clamps, or DIN-mountable terminal blocks to connect devices safely. These components allow integration into the existing busbar system without compromising safety.
- **Reconfigure Existing Connections:** In some cases, branch circuits can be connected to existing busbars at the sides or bottom of the cabinet, provided there is sufficient clearance and the connections comply with electrical standards.
