

# How to run a network cable through a cable tray



## Article Overview

To connect a network cable into a cable tray, plan the route, secure the tray, and carefully lay and fasten the cables while maintaining separation and grounding.

### Step 1: Plan the Cable Tray Route

Before installing any cables, map out the tray layout considering the location of network switches, patch panels, and other equipment. Ensure the route avoids interference with electrical lines and allows for future expansion . Mark the path clearly and check for adequate clearance and load capacity.

### Step 2: Install and Connect the Cable Tray

Choose the appropriate tray type (ladder, wire mesh, solid-bottom) based on cable type and environment . Connect tray sections using splice plates, bolts, or proprietary connector kits to ensure alignment and structural stability . For angled or junction connections, use L, T, or cross-shaped plates. Ensure all tray sections are level and securely mounted with brackets or clamps spaced according to load requirements .

### Step 3: Lay the Network Cables

Place network cables into the tray carefully, avoiding sharp bends or kinks. Separate different cable types (e.g., power vs. data) using built-in dividers or additional separators to prevent interference . Maintain proper spacing to allow airflow and reduce heat buildup.
