

# How to use the jumperless splice tray



## Overview

To use Jumperless, you simply plug in your components and then enter the connecting rows or Arduino pins via a Wokwi CLI (Command Line Interface) that creates the netlist file for you. If you want Jumperless, it is available on Tindie for \$299. Jumperless V5 lets you prototype like a nerdy wizard who can see electricity and conjure jumpers with a magic wand. It's an Integrated Development Environment (IDE) for hardware, with an analog-by-nature RP2350B dev board, a drawer full of wires, and a workbench full of test equipment (including a. Using a bunch of analog crosspoint switches wired together into one bigger switch, Jumperless makes real, fully analog hardware connections between any points on the board or the Arduino Nano header at the top via serial, instead of needing to use jumper wires. Developed by Kevin Capucho and first showcased on the Electromaker project hub, Jumperless eliminates the need for cumbersome jumper wires, making prototyping.
