Key Principles for Efficient DB Wiring

1. Use Protective Devices: Install MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers) for overcurrent protection and RCDs/RCBOs for earth fault protection. RCBOs combine overcurrent and residual current protection per circuit, reducing unnecessary tripping and preventing energy waste from faults . 2. Load Balancing: Distribute circuits evenly across phases in a three-phase DB to prevent overloading a single phase, which can cause rapid energy draw and inefficiency . For single-phase systems, separate high-current appliances (like cookers or heaters) onto dedicated circuits . 3. Circuit Allocation and Grouping: Group circuits logically by function or area (e.g., lighting, sockets, high-current appliances). This allows selective isolation and prevents unnecessary power draw from unused areas . 4. Dedicated Circuits for High-Load Devices: Appliances such as electric showers, EV chargers, immersion heaters, and cookers should have dedicated radial circuits. Sharing these with general outlets can lead to rapid consumption and tripping . 5. Proper Grounding and Neutral Connections: Ensure all neutral and earth connections are correctly wired to prevent leakage currents, which can contribute to energy loss and unsafe conditions . 6. Use Energy-Efficient Wiring Practices:

- Correct cable sizing according to load prevents voltage drops and overheating.
- Avoid unnecessary long runs or loops that increase resistance and energy loss.
