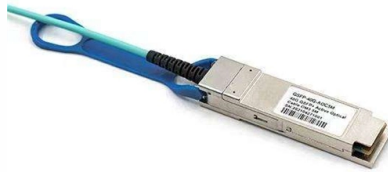


Huawei Fiber Optic Cable Project in Brazil



Overview

Sao Paulo, Brazil, October 9, 2024 — At the LATAM Fiber Broadband Leaders' Summit 2024 held in Brazil, Huawei launched three state-of-the-art digital fiber solutions aimed at fast-tracking Latin America's transition to gigabit fiber broadband.
