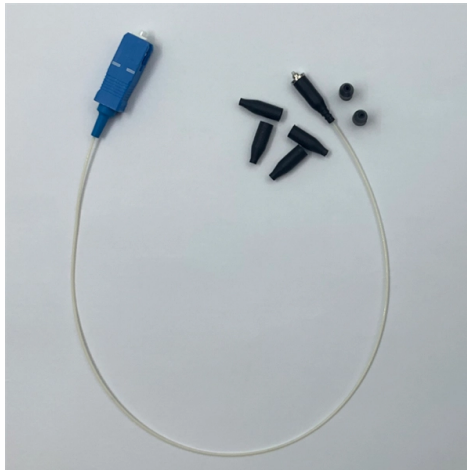


Indoor corridor optical cable laying using tray method



Article Overview

Optical fiber cables in indoor corridors can be safely and efficiently installed using cable trays, following NEC guidelines, proper handling, and structured supervision.

Cable Tray Selection and Preparation

For indoor corridor installations, cable trays such as ladder, trough, channel, or solid-bottom trays are commonly used. These trays provide an open pathway for optical cables, allowing easy access and maintenance while ensuring mechanical protection. Before installation, all materials should be inspected for damage, stored horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports, and verified against approved shop drawings. The tray layout should be planned to avoid interference with other services and to maintain proper bend radii for the fiber cables.

Cable Handling and Preparation

Optical fiber cables must be handled carefully to prevent damage. Keep cables on reels or in protective coils until installation, and avoid stepping on or bending them sharply. Preconnectorized cables require pulling grips to isolate connectors from tensile loads, protecting them from abrasion and mechanical stress. Lubricants may be used during pulling, but any spills should be cleaned to prevent slips or hazards.

Installation Procedure

- Set up the work area: Barricade the corridor, establish clear communication between pull, feed, and monitoring points, and ensure ladders or scaffolding are safe
