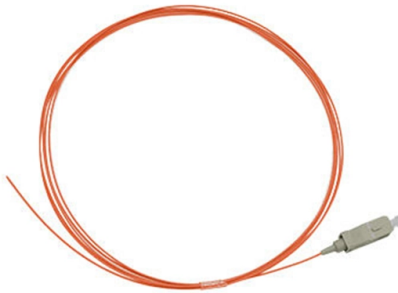


Installation of a quad-network integrated optical splitter

A quad-network integrated optical splitter can be installed using centralized or cascaded architectures, with careful attention to placement, split ratios, and fiber routing to ensure optimal PON performance.

Understanding the Optical Splitter

An optical splitter is a passive device that divides a single optical signal from an OLT into multiple outputs for ONTs, enabling one fiber to serve multiple subscribers efficiently. Quad-network integrated splitters typically provide four outputs per input, allowing simultaneous distribution across multiple network segments. Splitters can be FBT (Fused Biconical Taper) for small splits or PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) for larger, uniform splits.

Splitter Architectures

- Centralized Splitting
- A single-stage splitter is installed near the OLT or in a central cabinet.
- Structure: OLT → Optical Splitter → ONTs.
- Advantages: Easy customer reassignment via jumpers, simplified maintenance, and reduced fiber usage on the feeder side.
- Best for high-density areas where flexibility and centralized management are priorities.
