 - High performance over long distances, commonly used in telecom and data centers.
 - More expensive and requires precise installation.
- Multi-Mode Fiber (MMF):
 - Thicker core (50-62.5 microns) for shorter distances, such as LANs or building-to-building connections.
 - Easier and cheaper to install but limited in range.
- Plastic Fiber:
 - Budget-friendly, flexible, and suitable for short-range consumer setups.
