

Is the optical module plugged directly into the switch port



Article Overview

Optical modules should be plugged into the switch's SFP, SFP+, or other designated optical ports, not standard RJ45 Ethernet ports.

Choosing the Correct Port

Optical modules, such as SFP (Small Form-Factor Pluggable) or SFP+ transceivers, are designed to be inserted into SFP or SFP+ ports on a switch. These ports are modular and support fiber optic connections, enabling long-distance and high-speed data transmission, unlike standard RJ45 Ethernet ports which only support copper cables and shorter distances .

- SFP ports typically support 1 Gbps fiber connections.
- SFP+ ports support higher speeds, up to 10 Gbps, and are often backward-compatible with SFP modules at 1 Gbps, though SFP+ modules cannot be used in SFP ports .
- Combo ports may offer both RJ45 and SFP interfaces, but only one can be active at a time .

Installation Guidelines

- Handle the module carefully by its sides; avoid touching the card-edge connectors .
- Insert the module into the SFP/SFP+ port until it clicks into place. If the module has a handle, push it to secure the module .
