Overview

Single-point grounding is the most common and recommended method for grounding STP cables. In this topology, the shield of the STP cable is connected to the ground at one point, typically at the switch or rack. Shielded Twisted Pair (STP) cables are widely used in environments with high electromagnetic interference (EMI) and radio frequency interference (RFI). Let's take a closer look at why grounding. at work we are having a discussion on the grounding of F/UTP (Outer Foil Shield/Unshielded Twisted Pair) cable, basically 4 twisted pairs wrapped in thin aluminium tape. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
