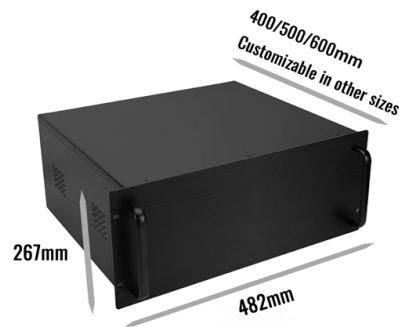

Material Selection

Ladder cable trays are typically made from cold-rolled steel for general applications or stainless steel for corrosive environments, while aluminum alloys are used for lightweight and corrosion-resistant applications. The choice of material depends on mechanical strength requirements, environmental conditions, and corrosion resistance. Stainless steel grades like AISI 316L are preferred in highly corrosive or chlorinated environments due to their chromium and molybdenum content.

Cutting and Forming

Materials are cut using CNC laser machines to achieve precise dimensions with minimal finishing. Cutting parameters are adjusted based on material thickness and type. The ladder structure is then formed using CNC bending machines, programmed for exact bend locations, angles, and depths. Regular calibration ensures consistent production and prevents material fatigue.

Fabrication of Bends and Fittings

- Elbows (45° and 90°): Use mandrel benders to maintain inner radius integrity and prevent crimping. Inspect with angle finders for uniformity.
- Tees and Crosses: Weld intersections with continuous seam welds to enhance structural integrity and reduce stress points. Ultrasonic testing can detect internal flaws.
