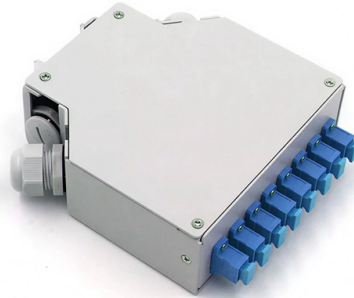


Leakage protection time of construction site electrical distribution box



Overview

(1) The rated leakage action current of the leakage protector in the main distribution box shall be 50-100ma, and the rated leakage action time shall be greater than 0.1s.
