

Method for splicing optical cables broken on iron towers

3. **Clean the Fiber** Clean the stripped fiber with 99.9% isopropyl alcohol and lint-free wipes to remove any dust, oils, or debris. Contaminants can cause high attenuation or back reflection.
4. **Cleave the Fiber Ends** Use a precision fiber cleaver to create a flat, perpendicular end-face. Proper cleaving ensures optimal alignment and minimal signal loss during fusion.
5. **Fusion Splicing** Place the prepared fiber ends into a fusion splicer. The splicer aligns the fiber cores automatically and uses an electric arc to fuse the ends together, creating a continuous optical path. Fusion splicing typically results in very low insertion loss (around 0.1 dB) and high mechanical strength.
6. **Protect the Splice** After fusion, protect the splice with a heat-shrink sleeve or splice protector to prevent mechanical damage and environmental exposure. This is especially important for outdoor installations on towers.
