Armored outdoor optical cables are designed with multiple protective layers to ensure mechanical strength, rodent resistance, and environmental durability for aerial, duct, or direct-burial installations.

Cable Structure

Core and Cladding: The central core, made of high-purity glass or plastic, carries the optical signal, while the cladding surrounds the core to confine light and minimize signal loss . **Strength Members:** Aramid fibers, fiberglass rods, or steel elements provide tensile strength, preventing stretching or bending damage during installation and operation . **Water-Blocking Elements:** Gel-filled or dry water-blocking materials prevent moisture ingress, protecting fibers from water-related damage . **Armor Layer:** Armored cables include a metallic layer, typically corrugated steel or aluminum, which protects against crushing, rodent attacks, and mechanical impacts. Armor can be applied over loose-tube or ribbon fiber designs and is essential for direct-burial installations . **Outer Jacket:** The outer sheath, usually polyethylene (PE) or PVC, provides UV resistance, abrasion protection, and environmental durability . **Fiber Arrangement:** Loose-tube cables contain fibers in buffer tubes, while ribbon cables stack multiple fibers for high-density splicing and mass fusion installation .

Types of Armored Cables

- **Metallic Armor Cable:** Uses corrugated steel tape or stainless steel tubing for mechanical protection and moisture resistance. Can be single or double jacketed, uni-tube or multi-tube .
