Indoor cables often feature FRP (Fiber Reinforced Plastic) for non-conductive reinforcement and LSZH jackets for fire safety, while outdoor cables incorporate steel or aramid yarn for tensile strength, UV resistance, and water-blocking layers to withstand wind, ice, and moisture. Round drop cables provide superior crush resistance for underground or duct installations.

Flexibility and Bend Performance: Modern drop cables are lightweight and compact, allowing easy routing through walls, conduits, and tight spaces without compromising performance. Their minimum bend radius is significantly smaller than legacy fibers, which reduces the risk of macrobends and microbends that can degrade signal quality.

Span and Support: Self-supporting figure-8 drop cables with steel or FRP messenger wires can span up to 50 meters under standard conditions, with specialized designs exceeding 80 meters, making them suitable for aerial pole-to-house deployments.
