

Pre-shipment acceptance testing of relay protection devices

Pre-shipment acceptance testing ensures that relay protection devices meet specifications, operate correctly under fault conditions, and are free from manufacturing defects before delivery.

Purpose of Pre-Shipment Testing

Pre-shipment acceptance testing is conducted to verify that protection relays comply with manufacturer specifications and relevant standards such as IEC 60255, IEEE C37.90, and, where applicable, IEC 61000, 60068, and 60529 . The tests confirm that the relay will function correctly under abnormal power conditions and that both hardware and software components are free from defects . This step is critical to prevent failures in the field, as relay malfunctions may only become apparent during actual fault conditions.

Types of Tests

- **Type Tests** These are performed at the manufacturer's facility to demonstrate compliance with standards and to simulate real operating conditions. Type tests are comprehensive and include both hardware and software evaluation, particularly for digital or numerical relays .
- **Routine Tests** Routine tests are conducted on each relay unit to ensure it meets the specified performance criteria. These tests typically include functional verification under controlled environmental conditions and may involve secondary injection testing to simulate fault currents .
