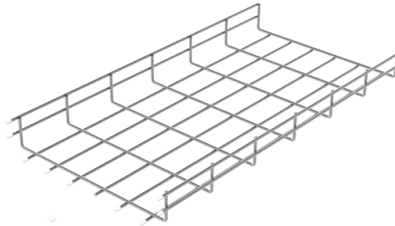


Regulations on the Installation Height of Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

Distribution boxes should generally be installed at a height of 1.4 to 1.8 meters for wall-mounted indoor use, with adjustments for outdoor, floor-mounted, or special accessibility needs.

Recommended Heights

- Indoor wall-mounted boxes: Typically 1.4 to 1.7 meters (4.5 to 5.5 feet) from the floor, which allows easy access without bending or stretching and keeps the box out of reach of children .
- Residential use: A height of around 1.5 meters is common, balancing accessibility and safety .
- Special groups: For children, elderly, or disabled individuals, the height should be adjusted to ensure safe and convenient access .
- Outdoor boxes: Should be installed at least 0.9 meters (3 feet) above the ground to protect against water, dirt, and accidental impacts .
- Floor-mounted boxes: The back panel should be at least 0.5 to 0.6 meters above the ground, with additional clearance in damp environments .

Safety and Functional Considerations

- Dry and ventilated location: Install boxes in areas free from moisture, dust, and corrosive substances to prevent electric shock and equipment damage .
