

Removing the cold joint

Cold joints can be effectively repaired by cleaning, roughening, applying bonding agents, and patching with high-strength or polymer-modified concrete to restore structural integrity.

Understanding Cold Joints

A cold joint occurs when fresh concrete is poured against a layer that has already begun to set, creating a weak interface that can compromise strength, durability, and water resistance . They are often visible as horizontal or vertical seams and may lead to cracking or leakage if not addressed .

Steps to Remove or Repair a Cold Joint

1. Surface Preparation

- **Cleaning:** Remove all debris, dust, and loose concrete using a stiff brush, vacuum, or high-pressure water jet .
 - **Mechanical Roughening:** Use a wire brush, sandblaster, or diamond grinder to roughen the surface, creating a textured profile that enhances bonding .
 - **Depth Assessment:** Ensure the joint is deep enough to provide a mechanical key for the repair material without compromising surrounding concrete .
- #### 2. Applying Bonding Agents

- Use a concrete bonding adhesive or slurry coat on the prepared surface to improve adhesion between the old and new concrete layers .
 - Follow manufacturer instructions for application and curing times to maximize effectiveness.
