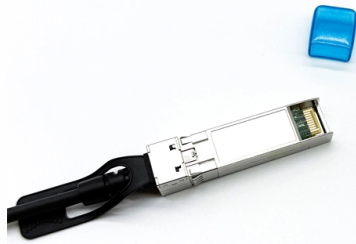


Removing the rack network module

Turn off the server and peripheral devices and disconnect the power cords and all external cables (see Power off the server). If the server is installed in a rack, slide the server out on its rack slide rails to gain access to the top cover, or remove the server from the. Ensure that you have the following parts and tools available to power off the switch: A cable to connect the external management device to the console port (CONSOLE) or management port (<. >) on the primary Routing Engine module (RE module). Removing a Switch from a Rack

For two-post installations, carefully slide the switch out of the rack. For four-post installations, carefully slide the switch forward out of the cabinet and off the rear

Remove a Device from a Two-Post Rack

Tilt the device so that the brackets are clear of the rack posts, and carefully lift it out of the rack. If the device cannot be tilted (because other equipment is mounted directly above and below), remove one
