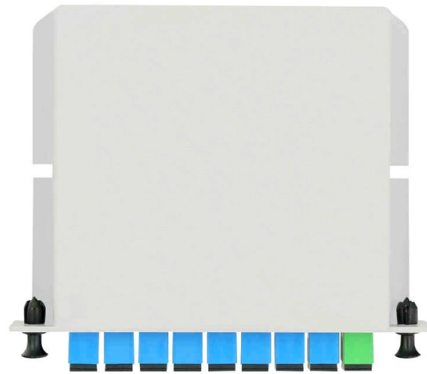


Requirements for cable tray installation through walls



Article Overview

Wall-mounted cable trays must be securely supported, properly spaced, grounded, and comply with NEC Article 392 for safe and code-compliant installations.

Structural Support and Mounting

Cable trays installed on walls require secure mounting using brackets or clamps designed for the tray type and load. Supports should typically be spaced 1.5 to 3 meters apart, depending on the tray type, material, and cable weight, to prevent sagging or mechanical failure. Ladder trays, ventilated troughs, and solid-bottom trays each have different load capacities and support requirements, with ladder trays allowing longer spans due to their structural design.

Tray Type Selection

- Ladder trays: Best for heavy power cables, excellent ventilation, and easy cable entry.
- Ventilated trough trays: Moderate ventilation, suitable for medium-voltage or smaller cables.
- Solid-bottom trays: Maximum protection from debris or fluids but limited heat dissipation; fill rules are more restrictive.

Cable Fill and Separation

- Fill limits: Power cables should not exceed 40% of the tray cross-sectional area, and control or signal cables should not exceed 50%.
