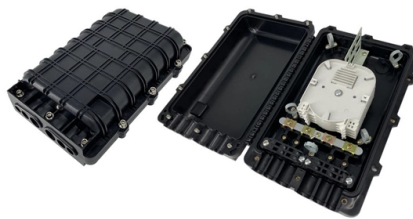


Requirements for the installation of electrical distribution box equipment rooms

1 Pre-installation Requirements for Transformers and Substations: - The indoor ceiling and wall finishes should be completed with no water leakage. Site selection requirements: The distribution box should be installed in an area close to the power supply to reduce. An electrical room is a room or dedicated space used to house electrical equipment such as switchboards, panelboards, motor control equipment, disconnects, transformers, or similar distribution equipment.
