Perforated Cable Tray

A perforated cable tray features a solid bottom with evenly spaced holes and raised side rails. It provides moderate ventilation while offering continuous support for cables. This type is suitable for commercial buildings, control rooms, and instrumentation wiring, balancing airflow and cable protection .

Solid-Bottom Cable Tray

The solid-bottom cable tray is fully enclosed, providing complete protection against dust, moisture, and electromagnetic interference. It is ideal for sensitive installations such as data centers, hospitals, and clean rooms. Optional covers can further enhance protection, but ventilation is limited, so it is best for low-heat-generating cables .
