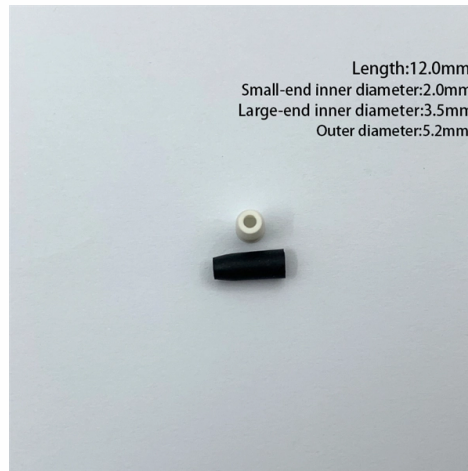


Sag of ground wire and optical cable
