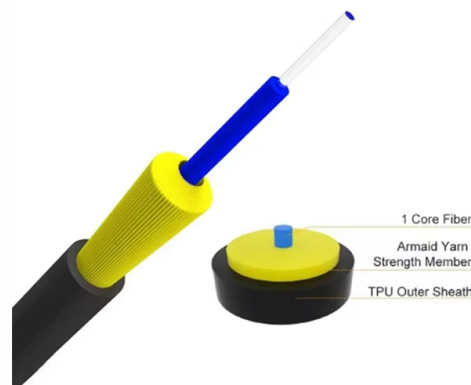


# Self-supporting aerial optical cable laying



## Article Overview

Self-supporting aerial optical cables, such as ADSS and figure-8 types, are designed to span between poles without additional support, allowing safe and efficient fiber optic deployment.

### Types of Self-Supporting Aerial Cables

- **ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting):** Non-metallic, lightweight, and capable of spanning up to 1000 meters between poles. Ideal for installation near power lines due to electrical isolation. Fibers are loosely distributed to prevent attenuation from cable deformation .
- **Figure-8 Cable:** Combines a steel messenger and optical fiber in a single figure-eight jacket. Provides high tensile strength and can span up to 180 meters. Variants include GYTC8S, GYXTC8Y, and GYXTC8S, offering water resistance, UV protection, and mechanical durability .

### Installation Considerations

- **Route Survey:** Conduct a thorough survey to identify utilities, streets, and obstacles. Ensure sufficient clearance from power lines and other cables according to the National Electrical Safety Code .
- **Poles:** Use dead-end poles to anchor the cable and intermediate poles to support spans. ADSS cables require careful attention to tension and sag, while figure-8 cables integrate the messenger for simpler installation .
- **Hardware:** Include spacers, straps, and suspension hardware to prevent chafing and maintain cable alignment. For lashed systems, proper spacing and tensioning of the messenger strand are critical .
