

Should the backup fiber optic cable be connected to a router

A fiber optic cable should not be connected directly to a standard router; it must first pass through an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) that converts the optical signal into an electrical signal your router can use.

Why the ONT is Necessary

Fiber optic signals transmit data as light pulses, which standard routers cannot interpret directly. The ONT, typically provided by your ISP, serves as the conversion point, translating the incoming optical signal into a standard Ethernet signal. This Ethernet output is then connected to the router's WAN or Internet port using a high-quality Ethernet cable .

Backup Fiber Considerations

If you have a backup fiber optic cable, it should also terminate at an ONT. You cannot simply plug it into the router. The backup ONT can either be a separate unit or integrated into a dual-ONT setup, depending on your ISP and network design. Once the ONT is active, you connect it to the router via Ethernet, just like the primary connection .

Best Practices

- Handle fiber connectors carefully: Avoid touching the glass ends to prevent signal degradation .
- Use the correct Ethernet cable: Cat6a or higher is recommended to maintain full fiber speeds .
