

Standard Requirements for Prefabricated Distribution Box Installation



Article Overview

Prefabricated distribution boxes must be installed in dry, accessible, and ventilated locations, with proper grounding, wiring, protection devices, and compliance with regional electrical standards.

Site Selection and Placement

- Install the distribution box close to the power supply to minimize power loss and ensure safety, avoiding humid, corrosive, or poorly ventilated areas to prevent overheating and equipment damage ().
- The recommended installation height is typically 1.5-1.8 meters above the ground for convenient operation and inspection ().
- Ensure the location allows easy access for maintenance and future upgrades, and consider environmental factors such as UV exposure, termites, or sand ingress depending on the region ().

Enclosure and Material Requirements

- Choose enclosures with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings to protect against water, dust, and environmental hazards. Outdoor or industrial applications may require IP55+ or IP65+ ().
- Materials can be steel for durability in harsh environments or plastic for lighter indoor applications ().
- Ensure corrosion resistance and UV stabilization for outdoor installations ().
